

Deep Creek Quarry was granted State Approval on the 24 January 2024 and Commonwealth Approval on 7 November 2024.

The Deep Creek Quarry is a State Significant hard rock quarry that will provide gravel and aggregate to local and regional areas for use in roads, concrete and landscaping. The quarry at peak production will produce up to 500,000 tonnes per year.

Construction

Construction is expected to commence in June 2026. Construction will include:

- Creation of a new intersection on The Bucketts Way, likely to take a few months to complete.
- Traffic control on The Bucketts Way will be required and we will aim to minimize disruption to passing traffic.
- Construction of roads, an office and workshop, stockpile areas and dams.
- Transport of heavy machinery into the site, with operators and service trucks accessing the site daily.
- We expect construction will take six to nine months before operations can commence.
- Blasting of rock will occur in small areas during construction. If you'd like notification (text or email) prior to a blast event please email community@deepcreekquarry.com.au.
